**Faculty Course Development and Course Enhancement Grant Application**

**Deadline: 5:00 p.m. on March 14, 2021**

With these grants, the Carolina Center for Jewish Studies supports faculty who are interested in developing new Jewish Studies courses in the College of Arts and Sciences. Courses should be open to enrollment by undergraduate students (though graduate students may also be included) and may be in any department. We are particularly interested in courses that will be regularly taught. Course development awards may be used for travel and research; for purchasing or development of print, electronic or audiovisual course materials; and for summer salary stipends. We will also accept proposals that seek to expand or enhance the level of Jewish Studies content in an established course. These funds can be used for one-time expenditures, including field trips, symposia featuring student research, guest speakers, and extracurricular activities that support a course with significant Jewish Studies content.

This proposal should 1) describe the course that is to be developed and its relation to the field of Jewish Studies OR if applying for a course enhancement grant, describe which course you are applying for and list the course, semester and actual or projected enrollment; 2) explain the importance of the grant to developing/enhancing the course and include a budget, 3) explain the importance of the course to the undergraduate curriculum and your home department, with a statement as to the likelihood that this course will be regularly offered, and 4) estimate the anticipated enrollment of the course.
- List other possible sources of funding for this initiative.
- Abbreviated current CV (no more than 3 pages in length).

***Faculty who receive a research and travel grant from the Carolina Center for Jewish Studies will be expected to submit a brief report detailing how the funds were used.***
